APPLICATION FOR BOOTH: INFORMATION SHEET

Images and object descriptions:

At least three images of the artists' work must be included with your application for each category you enter. Clear, up to date pictures with a good description are very important to help the selection committee facilitate your application.

The three images must be representative of the artwork you plan to sell at the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market. Work that is not representative of the classifications checked may be questioned and result in your application not being accepted.

All images, slides, descriptions, etc. will become the property of the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market, and will not be returned.

Collaborators must fill out separate applications and provide images and object descriptions.

One detail image (close up) is encouraged to show the quality of your work. The detail shot counts as one of your three images.

You may use a grouping of objects to represent your work but keep your images as uncluttered as possible.

Minimize glare by using non-reflective backgrounds. Use black (not white) background for photographing items with highly polished metal surfaces.

Potters, please indicate in your description if your pottery is kiln or traditionally fired.

GENERAL ARTWORK RULES

1. No artwork sold before Friday market opening.
2. All artwork in booths must be for sale
3. If there are not enough participants in a category, it may be added into the judging of another category at the discretion of the judges.
4. Artists are responsible for complying with Wisconsin Department of Revenue laws.
5. To be eligible for awards, the following guidelines must be met:
 - a. Artwork must be handmade by the registered artist within the last 18 months.
 - b. Artwork must follow the guidelines for its medium
 - c. Artwork must be sole property of the registered artist.
 - d. Artwork must be for sale during the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market.
 - e. Artwork must not have been commissioned.
 - f. Artwork cannot have been entered for awards at any previous Woodland Indian Art Show & Market.
 - g. Artwork must not include any part of an endangered species.
 - h. All two-dimensional art must be appropriately framed.
 - i. Accepted artists must provide proof of their Native American heritage.

ARTIST BOOTH RULES

1. Artists or their representatives must be at their booths at all times. The Woodland Indian Art Show & Market is not liable for any incidents that may occur if your booth is left vacant.
2. Beverages and snacks will be available to the artists throughout each day.
3. Please be respectful of other artists and their booth space. Artists must keep their art within the confines of their own registered booth space, unless granted prior permission by the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market officials.
4. Booths cannot be dismantled until the end of the market; this includes artists who have sold out of stock. Hours for the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market are Friday, July 3 and Saturday, July 4, 9 am -5pm.

5. Artists will be responsible for collecting and reporting sales tax on all items sold during the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market.
6. It is the artists' responsibility to comply with all federal and state laws regarding migratory birds and endangered species.
7. Books or videos of cultural, historic or educational content produced or pertaining to the artist as well as magazines or artist portfolios will be allowed for display but not for sale.
8. Prints and note cards are allowed for sale, as long as they depict original artwork of the registered artist. Also allowable are:
 - . Fiction or poetry must be the work of the artist.
 - . Tapes and CDs must be the work of the artist.
9. The goal of the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market is to display and sell fine art. Items not allowed for sale in booths include but are not limited to:
 - a. Commercially produced t-shirts, caps, mugs, mouse pads and non-handmade items.
 - b. Any medium other than those specifically accepted to the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market, unless previously authorized by a Woodland Indian Art Show & Market official.

The Woodland Indian Art Show & Market supports the Indian Arts and Crafts Act (1990). All work must be Indian made and is subject to verification of your enrollment in a federal or state-recognized tribe. Failure to comply will result in immediate disqualification. Artist must vacate the event. No fees will be refunded. All artists must follow the Jewelry Standards regarding use of materials. If feathers are used, they must comply with all current laws and regulations of State and Federal agencies.

Woodland Indian Art Show & Market officials will visit artist booths to ensure that the Market's rules and regulations are being observed.

Woodland Indian Art Show & Market officials reserve the right to prohibit an artist from participating in the market based on the failure to comply with these rules and regulations.

PAYMENT

\$50 Deposits for booth space will be accepted upon approval of application. **Or register early by May 15, 2009 to receive an early registration discount of \$125. Early registration must be paid in full.**

We will send a letter notifying you of your application acceptance. Cashiers' checks or money orders should be made payable to the Woodland Indian Arts Show & Market. The application fee is per artist; if you plan to share a booth with another artist, each artist sharing the booth must send in their own application.
