- 2. Youth application form signed by parent/guardian.**
- 3. A tribal Id from a federal or official state recognized tribe or letter from tribe, on letterhead, stating the applicant is an artisan for the tribe. (A formal letterhead stating decedancy from a tribe will be accepted).**

Preparing Artwork

In order to fully capture your audience, it is critical to display your artwork in a way that is easily viewed. Many times we create artwork without thinking of how it should be viewed. Do you want your audience to view your work in a specific way? Do you have something to say about your creation? These are all aspects to consider when presenting your final work, especially if it is going to be judged and juried.

Youth Artists must register their artwork for the juried competition either Thursday June 4th from 5:00pm-7:00pm or Friday June 5th from 8:00am to Noon at the Radisson Conference Center, to qualify for the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market.
