Preparing Artwork

In order to fully capture your audience, it is critical to display your artwork in a way that is easily viewed. Many times we create artwork without thinking of how it should be viewed. Youth Artists must register their artwork for the juried competition either Thursday June 4th from 5:00pm-7:00pm or Friday June 5th from 8:00am to Noon at the Radisson Conference Center, to qualify for the Woodland Indian Art Show & Market.
