#### Corn Husk Doll Making

Students will learn how to make an Oneida Corn Husk Doll during this online live-streaming class. The Haudenosaunee (translation: People of the Long House) tell the story of the Corn Husk Doll that was passed down through their oral tradition. In this story the message is to have humility and share the gifts Creator gave us.

#### Beginner Iroquois Strawberry Whimsy

Students will learn the basic pattern and structure of the Strawberry Whimsy using felt, beads, thread and needle. The beaded whimsies were invented by Tuscarora and Mohawk people in the late 1700's and were sold to tourists. Many Iroquois beadwork artists still create these unique whimsies. Many collectors are still interested in this art form.

#### Black Ash Bracelet class

Learn basic weaving with Rae Skenandore in the Black Ash Woven Bracelet class. The Black Ash tree is the preferred tree for splints for basket making. Students will use dye to color a few splints, and then weave splints over a metal bracelet form.
