Should you recognize any of the ill effects of the pandemic on your health, please use your discretion in determining if you should be tested or not. The choice is yours and the availability of test sites are readily available within our communities and in each county and state.

Should you know other friends, family members or acquaintances who were at the event, please inform them that they too, should take precautionary measures and be tested if they so choose.

The Woodland Indian Art, Inc. Board of Directors are all engaged in getting the word out by utilizing the event registration information collected on all recipients of this information, along with the notification of our performers, artists, guests and visitors.

As all precautionary attempts such as taking your temperature prior to entering the event area, requiring the wearing of a mask within the event areas, practicing social distancing everywhere and by the provision of sanitary hand cleansing locations throughout the event areas, we did follow the recommended CDC guidelines and were therefore, not required to cancel the event.

We further hope and pray that no one else was affected by this dreaded pandemic and that by continuing the safety practices as presented, please consider getting the vaccination and let's all participate in eradicating this pandemic as soon as possible.
